- 3.1 Receive a Community Health Board Report From the Community Health Services Administrator, Public Health Staff, and the Scott County Medical Director

Scott County Public Health Director Lisa Brodsky addressed the purpose of the meeting is to satisfy Minnesota Statute 145A which requires the Community Health Board to meet twice annually. Ms. Brodsky presented information that highlighted the work of Scott County Public Health in 2022 and programs currently underway.

State Health Improvement Partnership (SHIP) Coordinator Haley Miskowiec presented an overview of SHIP context areas, settings, and partnerships. Ms. Miskowiec shared SHIP data from the previous seven years.

Public Health Data Planner Khalif Maalim presented the results of the 2022 Minnesota Student Survey, which tracks mental health, general health, and alcohol, tobacco & other drug trends among students. Three school districts in Scott County contributed to the survey, Shakopee, Prior Lake – Savage, and Belle Plaine.

Scott County Medical Director Dr. Michael Wilcox provided a COVID-19 vaccination update. Dr. Wilcox outlined changes in vaccine products and protocols for children. Scott County continues to offer COVID vaccine clinics and has integrated COVID vaccinations with other vaccine clinics.
